General Rules

- 1. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 2. No glass containers of any kind are allowed in the pool area.
- 3. Smoking is prohibited in the pool area.
- 4. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- 5. Proper swim wear is required.
- 6. No running, pushing, wrestling, using profanity or causing undue disturbance in the pool area.
- 7. No hard balls, i.e. tennis balls, footballs allowed in the pool.
- 8. No diving in the shallow end of the pool.
- 9. Do not distract the lifeguards or loiter at the lifeguard stands or in the lifeguard office.
- 10. Do not climb on the lifeguard chairs.
- 11. Do not climb on or jump off the diving blocks.
- 12. Do not hang on or play on the lifeline or lane ropes.
- 13. The baby pool is for children under the age of 6. All children must be monitored by a responsible adult in the baby pool area.
- 14. Swim diapers only, no disposable diapers are permitted in the pool.

Deep End

- 15. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time. Do not dive or jump off the side of the board jump straight out.
- 16. Do not hang on the diving board.
- 17. No floatation devices including swimmies or floaties are allowed in the deep end. A responsible adult must accompany individuals reliant on a floatation device at all times.
- 18. No general swimming is permitted in the deep end unless the diving board is closed off by the pool staff.
- 19. During the times when no lifeguard is on duty, the deep end and diving board are closed. This is non-negotiable.

Safety Break

20. A 10 minute safety break (adult swim) will be observed each hour by anyone under the age of 18. Anyone under 18 must be completely out of the water at this time - no sitting on the edge or on the steps.

*The 10 minute safety break cannot begin until <u>all</u> underage swimmers are out of the water. This is non-negotiable.
